

## **Bargo Instructions and Rules**

### **Instructions:**

With your registration you should have received these instructions and a packet of cards. The cards are meant to be printed at home. The packet also includes a packet number. You'll need to know what packet number you have so we can verify your wins. To keep things fair among all our participants we are keeping track of who has what cards. This is designed to prevent anyone from playing more than one card per game and gives everyone involved the same chance to win. You'll notice on your cards, there is a serial number on the bottom. For the first game you'll play the first card in the sequential order, second game, second card, etc. When you call bargo you will tell us what packet we have and we'll be able to pull up your card to verify the accuracy. We will play 5 rounds. The final round is a cover-all.

In order to participate, players will need access to Facebook. We are broadcasting using the Facebook Live feature. Navigate to either of the B-52 pages and simply click on the video to follow along. The video will begin a few minutes before 7:00 but games will not begin until 7:00. Please be ready to play at 7:00 as we have a fun program for everyone including multiple drawings.

### **Rules:**

1. Winners must be over 21 to accept a prize. Bargo is free to play.
2. Only one card may be played per round. In order for multiple people to play in the same household, each participant must register with a unique email and name, winners must be able to validate their identification.
3. When a bargo is won, type in, "Bargo, Pack X, Ball X" in the chat and verify what pack number you are playing, and what ball you won on. We may need to ask where the bargo is on the card, depending on the game. There can be a delay of varying lengths of time between when we call numbers and when players at home receive them. These delays, while not consistent, tend to run around 10 seconds. It's possible for someone to have won a bargo and we might not know yet and call another number. While we do our best to account for delays, winners won't need to have won on the last number called, within relatively close time. If a bargo is called and we didn't catch it with the delay we will back up to the ball order that was the initial winner.
4. In the event of a tie, we will make a final call for any other bargos and have a drawing between the winning packs.
5. Once a winner is confirmed and the game is closed, no other winners will be accepted.
6. All decisions made by the hosts are final and we reserve the right to make announced changes to the rules as necessary.

All prizes must be picked up at the B-52 Lakeville Location.
